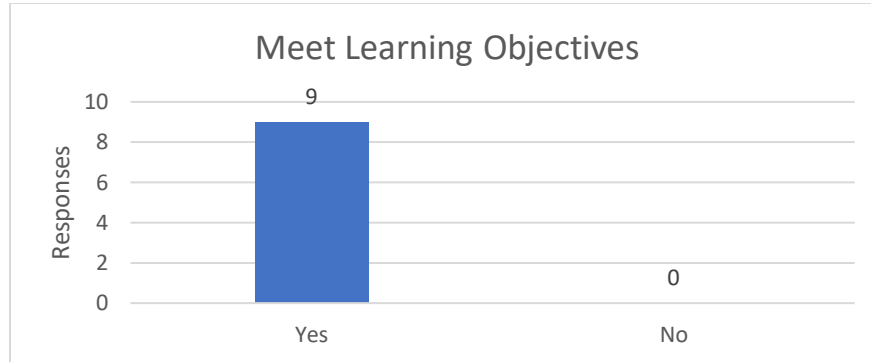

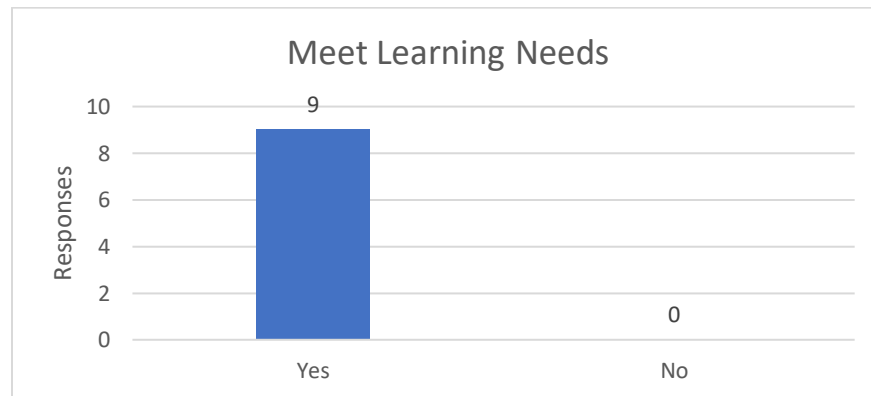
Recruiting Medical Students to Rural Health on a Shoestring Budget

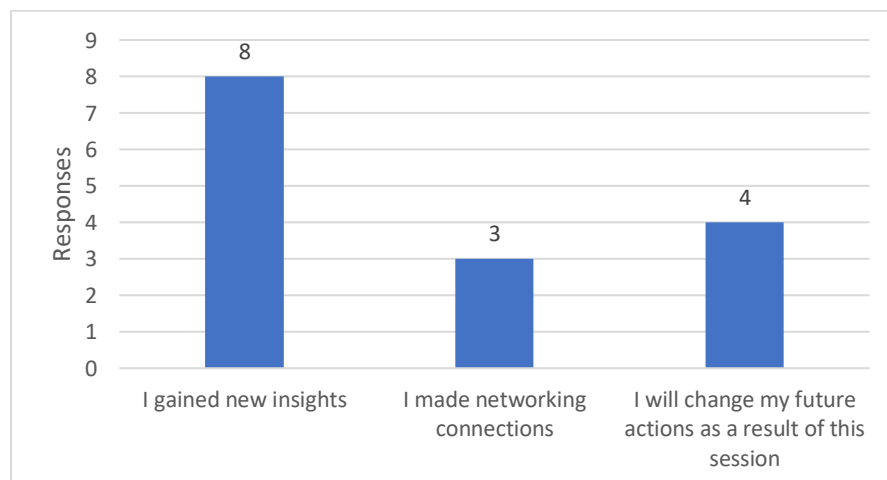

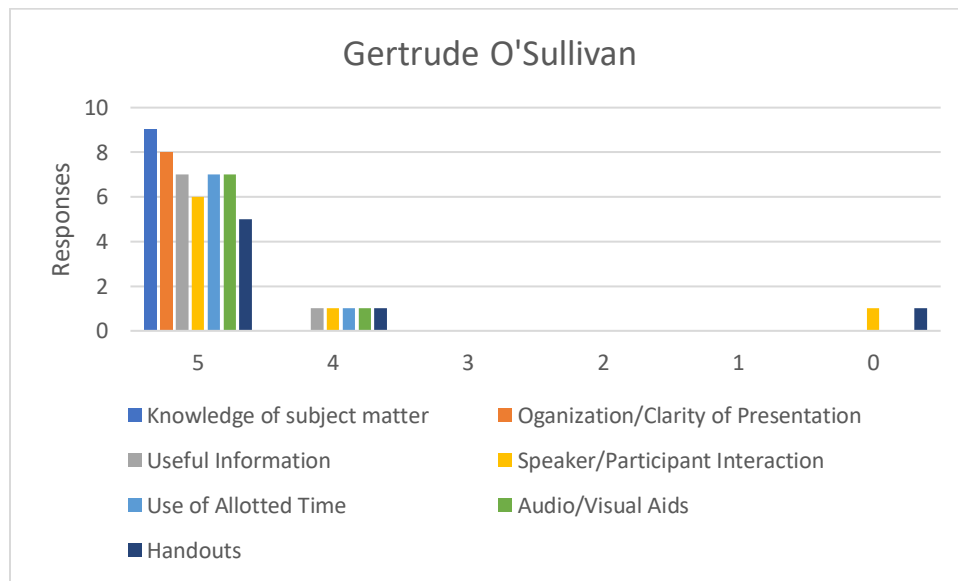

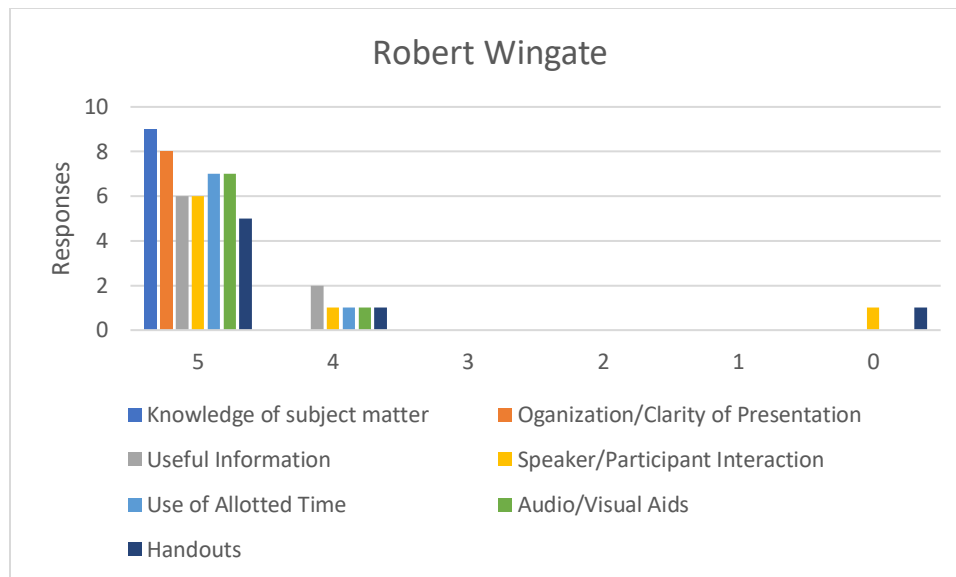

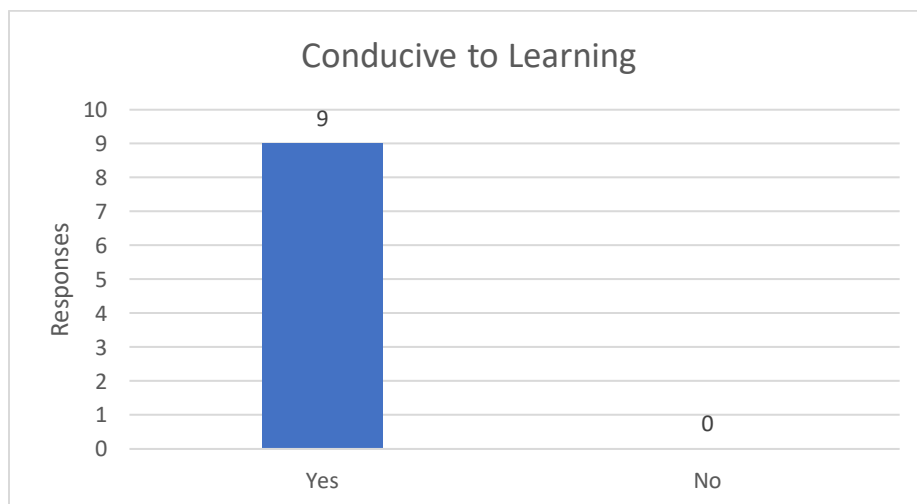
