NYSARH has embarked on a bold effort to enhance its presence in New York State and provide measurable benefit to its members and improve rural health. NYSARH worked in 2018 with NRHA to conduct a Strategic Planning session and process. The results of the process have targeted six priority areas: 1) Advocacy; 2) Membership Development; 3) Networking; 4) Capacity Building; 5) Partnership Development, and; 6) System Transformation. NYSARH determined that Capacity Building was the highest priority, given that the other targeted priorities will be more favorably influenced and achieved if NYSARH has the capacity to address them in a coordinated and effective fashion. To this end, NYSARH has committed to re-engineering its staffing arrangement, and effective July 1, 2019 contracted with a partner/partner organization to provide a comprehensive set of specific services that will allow NYSARH to greatly increase its capacity to deliver value to its members and influence positive rural health policy.
