Call to Order	Meeting convened at 3:02 pm	No agenda modifications.		
Senate Appropriation	Karen Madden presented information. The Office of Rural Health (ORH) will contract with NYSARH. NYSARH will contract with 32 RHNs and 44 rural hospitals. ORH is preparing the budget and work plan. They have determined the amount of each grant based on a formula [percentage of main grant]. Recipients will have broad discretion to spend funds on 'activities that support the goals of the program'. Expenses incurred 4/1 – 9/30 may be claimed and paid with a 25% Advance. Funds need to be expended by 3/31/20. Discussion:  • Lack of Board notification of funding opportunity • Timeline of events leading up to call • No Board approval to accept funding; review for capacity, fit to mission, vision, values • NYSARH needs to review our policies.
