Overarching Comments:

- ✓ This money is temporary.
- ✓ Funds should be focused on projects or pilots that prove something that could be incorporated as new policy or promising practice.
- ✓ Request that DOH consider a 'rural lens' to allow flexibility and innovation required to respond to the needs of rural communities.

Discussion Themes

- Recruitment, retention, pipeline and training
- Build an infrastructure for professional preceptor supervisory time sustainable through VBP funding
- Study to look at caseloads/burnout/job jumping in behavioral health
- Develop community paramedicine
- Population health is broader than Medicaid; Health Across All Policies
- Current initiatives have led to burdensome data collection
- Rural broadband
