Dear State Leaders:

On behalf of the undersigned, we are writing to respectfully request that NYS dedicate \$16.2 million to the New York State Rural Health Programs for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 to move toward our shared goal of achieving **health equity for rural New Yorkers.**

Rural communities are challenged by disparities in healthcare access AND health outcomes as a function of rurality.

- Disparities in healthcare access include:
 - geographic isolation
 - limited number of healthcare specialists and sub-specialists
 - difficulties with transportation
 - poor broadband service
 - poverty
- Disparities in healthcare outcomes include:
 - higher incidence of disease and disability
 - increased mortality rates
 - lower life expectancies
 - higher rates of pain and suffering

The Rural Healthcare Access Development Program and the Rural Health Network Development Program were created in 1997 to assist rural health care providers in extending and maintaining services in rural communities. These programs support rural healthcare providers to collaboratively diversify and expand services, bolster emergency preparedness, deliver disease prevention programs, and engage with other organizations to encourage rural communities to foster mental and physical wellness.

In 2016 Rural Health Programs were allocated \$16.2 million. Since then, the Executive Budget has repeatedly reduced funding to these programs to \$9.4 million. **The NYS Association for Rural Health respectfully requests the addition of \$6.8 million in funding for Rural Health programs in the 2023-24 Budget.**
