
Youth often go against parental beliefs: in music, values, government, politics, sexuality, gender roles, culture.

**"Those who do not know history are doomed to repeat it."**

Currently ~3 million Americans 50+ identify as LGBT, expected to double to ~7 million by 2030!

- Older LGBTQ+ people may have trauma from being considered mentally ill <sup>(1973)</sup> when young.

- Thousands of LGBTQ+ citizens die earlier than straight citizens because they are isolated and afraid to seek care.


